The Syracuse University Sport Management Club (SPM Club) is excited to announce that the <u>21st Annual Charity Sports Auction</u> will be taking place this fall semester, supporting the nonprofit organization, <u>Upstate Golisano Children's Hospital!</u>

#### WHAT IS FALK FRIDAY?

Over the past 20 years, Syracuse University Falk College students have worked under the leadership of auction founder and Former Sport Management department chair, Professor Michael Veley. Since the auction began, hard working students have raised over \$760,000 for various non-profit organizations throughout the Central New York community.

Each year, the auction is hosted by two student co-chairs. **This year's chairs are James Stickel ('26) and Emily Gilbert ('27).** The students will work towards raising awareness to help promote effective family support for the 21st Auction's beneficiary.

To make this event possible, students dedicate much of their time over the summer and throughout the fall semester to collect items for the auction, source partnerships and sponsors, and market the event. Most items available at the auction fall under the category of sports memorabilia; however there are also trips, packages, and many products available to bid on. The event is held each year in the JMA Wireless Dome during a Syracuse Men's Basketball game. The auction not only provides an amazing opportunity to raise awareness for a community in need, but also a chance

for students to develop several professional skills, including sales and marketing, through a community engagement-focused role.

While Auction founder Michael Veley retired from Syracuse University in the Summer of 2024, he remains involved in the event and has passed the auction advisor reins to Sport Analytics Associate Professor, Dr. Jeremy Losak. If his dedication to Falk College wasn't enough, Dr. Losak also co-advises the SPM Club, Sport Analytics Living Learning Community, Baseball Statistics and Sabermetrics Club, and the Football Analytics Blitz competition.
